Overview and Definitions

This privacy policy ("Policy") describes how Vital and its related companies ("Company", "us", "our", and "we") collect, use and share personal information of consumer users of this website, www.vitalcard.com (the "Site"), the Vital Mobile Application (the "App"), or by any other means. By accessing this Site, our App, or interacting with the Company through other websites or social media, you acknowledge and agree to be bound by this Policy. This Policy must be read in conjunction with our Terms of Use, and the provisions of such terms are incorporated herein.

What We Collect

We receive information about you in a variety of ways. **Information You Give Us.** We collect your name, postal address, email address, phone number, username, password as well as other information you directly and voluntarily provide us on our Site, our App, or through contacting us. **Information We Get from Others.** We may get information about you from other sources. We may add this to information you give us. **Information Automatically Collected.** We automatically log information about you and your device. For example, when visiting our Site or App, we log your device type, operating system type, browser type, browser language, the website you visited before browsing to our Site, pages you viewed, how long you spent on a page, access times and information about your use of and actions on our Site or App. When we communicate with you via email, text message, SMS, or push notifications, we may collect information in relation to the communications to include confirmation of delivery, action, viewing, and use. **Cookies.** We may log information using "cookies." Cookies are small data files stored on your hard drive by a website. We may use both session Cookies (which expire once you close your web browser) and persistent Cookies (which stay on your computer until you delete them) to provide you with a more personal and interactive experience on our Site. This type of information is collected to make the Site more useful to you and to tailor the experience with us to meet your special interests and needs.

Use of Personal Information

We use your personal information to operate, maintain, and improve our sites, products, and services. We use your personal information to respond to comments and questions and provide customer service. We use your personal information to send information including confirmations, invoices, technical notices, updates, security alerts, and support and administrative messages. We use your personal information to communicate about promotions, upcoming events, and other news about products and services offered by us and our selected partners. We use your personal information to link or combine user information with other personal information. We use your personal information to protect, investigate, and deter against fraudulent, unauthorized, or illegal activity. We use your personal information to provide and deliver products and services customers request.

Use of Anonymized & Aggregated Statistics

We may from time to time aggregate and anonymize data that we collect, and we may use this information for various business purposes where permissible under applicable laws and regulations. The data aggregated and anonymized may be derived from personal and non-personal information and used internally to improve our products and services as well as shared with third party service providers and partners. Similarly, our service providers and partners may also share with us aggregated and anonymized data that was collected in independent interactions with you.

We share your information in accordance with the specifications outlined in the “Sharing Your Information” section outlined in this policy.

Protecting Your Information

We adopt appropriate data collection, storage and processing practices and security measures to protect against unauthorized access, alteration, disclosure or destruction of your personal information, username, password, transaction information and data stored on our Site or App.

Third Party Websites

You may find advertising or other content on our Site or App that link to the Websites and services of our partners, suppliers, advertisers, sponsors, licensors and other third parties. We do not control the content or links that appear on these Websites and are not responsible for the practices employed by Websites linked to or from our Website. In addition, these Websites or services, including their content and links, may be constantly changing. These Websites and services may have their own privacy policies and customer service policies. Browsing and interaction on any other Website, including Websites which have a link to our Site, is subject to that Website’s own terms and policies.

Information Choices and Changes

How does VITAL Card protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.

Definitions

Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies.
Non-Affiliates	<p>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies.</p> <p><i>Non-affiliates we share with can include insurance companies, service providers, co-branded partners, retailers, data processors, membership clubs, companies engaged in selling of consumer products and services, financial services companies, banks, and mortgage servicing companies.</i></p>
Joint Marketing	<p>A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.</p> <p><i>Our joint marketing partners include companies such as financial services companies and other financial institutions.</i></p>
